

Dear Brothers in Christ

I hear a lot about God the Father, Jesus the Son of God, and the Bible. What I don't hear a lot about is the **Third part of the Godhead** who is a person in His own right. He is the **Third part of God**. The bible says it's God The Father, Jesus the Son, and **the Holy Spirit**. But, the Holy Spirit seems to be the forgotten One of the Trinity. God made us, Jesus came to save us, but the **Holy Spirit** is the One who keeps us Hallelujah!!!! Genesis the first book of the bible makes mention, and reference to the **Third part of God as the Spirit of God**. Lets look at **Genesis 1:2** (God's Word v) The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep water. **The Spirit of God** was hovering over the water. Notice the statement **the Spirit of God** was hovering over the water. The Spirit of God did not move unless God spoke words, and then the Spirit took God's words and gave form to them. Look at verse **3**.

Then God said, "Let there be light!" So there was light. Well if you read the rest of that chapter you will see in verses 6,9,11,14,20,24, that it says, "and God said", and every time God said, He would also say that, "it is good". So every time God Said, the **Spirit of God** would stop hovering, and begin to form every word, **God would speak into existence**. Well, six times God said, and The Spirit of God brought it into existence. But the seventh time God said, "God said", it was a little different. The number seven always represents God and earth, Gods number is three, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. While the earths number is four, you can go four different directions, north, south, east, or west. There are four seasons, winter, spring summer, and fall. There are four phases of the moon and etc... So $3+4=7$ One of Gods favored numbers through out the bible. Well in verse 26, 27, it says.

26 God said, Let Us make humans in **Our image, in Our likeness**. Let them rule the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the domestic animals all over the earth, and all the animals that crawl on the earth."

27 So God created humans in **His image. In the image of God** He created them. He created them male and female. (God's Word v) Well to me, when God said let Us make man or humans in **Our image and in Our likeness**, He was not alone. It is obvious, not Only was the Holy Spirit there, but Jesus was too **Hallelujah!!!!** Well lets not just take my word on this subject, lets see if I can back this statement up. John 1:1-4, says

1 In the beginning the **Word already existed**. The **Word** was with God, and the **Word** was God. 2 **He was already with God in the beginning**. 3 Everything came into existence **through Him**. Not one thing that exists was made without Him. 4 **He was the source of life, and that life was the light for humanity**.(God's Word v)

So we can see Genesis says The Spirit of God was there, but John 1:1 lets us know Jesus was there also. In The king James verse 14 says, and the Word became flesh and dwelt

among us. **Hallelujah!!!!** So there is a record of the Trinity existing in the beginning of time, creating this world with God. We know that Jehovah means **Self-Existing God**, and Elohim means **the God of the laws, or the God who made the laws**. We don't know when this Self-Existing God became a Trinity God but He did **Hallelujah!!!!** Who knows everything about God? I sure don't, let me be the first one to say that to you. The more I find out about Him the more I know how little I know about Him. But the more I search for Him, the more I want to know about Him. I want more and more of Him in my life, in my heart, in my soul, and mind **Hallelujah!!!!** Well lets get back to the Third Part of God, the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God. The missing One in our generation, the part of God that many of us are not familiar with. We hear talk about Him every now and then, referring to the scriptures in the bible. But we don't hear a lot about letting the Holy Spirit live in us, or letting Him lead us into all truth, and showing us all things that are of God. And we sure do not allow Him to take control of our services or gathering we have in the name of the Lord. I just want the presence of God in my life, not sometimes, but all the time. I would like to meet with others who feel the same way. Just give me Jesus in the Presence of the Holy Spirit, not your talent, not your ability, not your hype, but Him, and Him alone. Well lets look at what Jesus said about the Holy Spirit when He was here. Lets look at what Jesus said the Holy Spirit would be to us when He got here, yes the forgotten part of God that must not be forgotten any longer. Well lets begin with Jesus' references to the Holy Spirit, lets go.

John 14:16-20 25-29 (M King

James v)

16 And I will pray the Father, and He shall give **you** another **Comforter**, so that He may **be with you forever**, **17** **the Spirit of Truth**, whom the world cannot receive because it does not see Him nor know Him. But you know Him, for **He dwells with you and shall be in you**. **18** **I will not leave you orphans**. I will come to you.

19 Yet a little *while* and the world does not see Me any more. But you see Me. Because I live, you shall live also. **20** At that day you shall know that **I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you**.

25 I have spoken these things to you, being present with you. **26** But the **Comforter, the Holy Spirit** whom the **Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things and bring all things to your remembrance, whatever I have said to you**.

27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. **28** You have heard how I said to you, I go away and I am coming to you *again*. If you loved Me, you would rejoice because I said, I go to the Father, for My Father is greater than I. **29** **And now I have told you before it happens, so that when it happens you might believe**.

What is it that Jesus wants you to believe when it happens? I am glad you asked. Its the coming of the Third part of the Trinity, the **Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God, The comforter, the Spirit of truth Hallelujah!!!!** Jesus said, He is coming **And now I have told you before it happens, so that when it happens you might believe Hallelujah!!!!** I am looking for some believers out there, can I find one praise God?

John 15:26-27 (M King James

v)

26 And **when the Comforter** has come, whom **I will send** to you from the Father, the **Spirit of truth** who proceeds from the Father, **He shall testify of Me.** **27** And you also shall bear witness, because you have been with Me from *the* beginning.

John 16:7-16 (M King James v)

7 But I tell you the truth, it is expedient for you that I go away; for if I do not go away, the **Comforter** will not come to you. But if I depart, **I will send Him to you.**
8 **And when that One comes, He will convict** the world concerning **sin**, and concerning **righteousness**, and concerning **judgment.** **9** Concerning **sin**, because they do not believe on Me; **10** concerning **righteousness**, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; **11** concerning **judgment**, because the ruler of this world is judged. **12** I have yet many things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. **13** However, **when He, the Spirit of Truth**, has come, **He will guide you into all truth.** For **He shall not speak of Himself, but whatever He hears, He shall speak. And He will announce to you things to come.** **14** He will glorify Me, for He will receive of Mine and will announce *it* to you. **15** All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that **He will take of Mine and will announce it to you.** **16** A little *while* and you will not see Me; and again a little *while*, and you will see Me, because I go to the Father.

So we can see when the Comforter comes He will, 1. Testify of Jesus, and bear witness of the truth. 2 Convict the world of their sins and righteousness and of judgment. 3 The Spirit of Truth will **guide you into all truth.** 4 **He shall not speak of Himself, but whatever He hears, He shall speak.** 5 **And He will announce to you things to come.** 6 **He will glorify Jesus.** 7 **He will receive from Jesus and will announce it to us Hallelujah!!!!** So we know Jesus said the Holy Spirit was coming, so lets see if it is true, did He the forgotten part of God really come. Lets see what the Word has to say about it.

Matthews 3:10-12(God's

Word v)

10 The ax is now ready to cut the roots of the trees. Any tree that doesn't produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into a fire. **11** **I baptize you with water so that you will change the way you think and act.** But the one who comes after me is more powerful than I. I am not worthy to remove His sandals. **He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.** **12** His winnowing shovel is in His hand, and He will clean up His threshing floor. He will gather His wheat into a barn, but He will burn the husks in a fire that can never be put out."

Luke 24:46-49 (King James v)

46 And said unto them, **Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to**

rise from the dead the third day: **47** And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His Name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. **48** And ye are witnesses of these things. **49** And, behold, I send the promise of My Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high. So did it ever happen as Jesus said it would, I am glad you asked? Lets take a look.

Acts 1:3-8 (God's Word

v)

3 After His death Jesus showed the apostles a lot of convincing evidence that He was alive. For 40 days He appeared to them and talked with them about the kingdom of God. **4** Once, while He was meeting with them, He ordered them not to leave Jerusalem but to wait there for what the Father had promised. Jesus said to them, "I've told you what the Father promises: **5** John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." **6** So when the apostles came together, they asked him, "Lord, is this the time when You're going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" **7** Jesus told them, "You don't need to know **about times or periods** that the Father has determined by His own authority. **8** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes to you. Then you will be My witnesses to testify about Me in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 2:1-4 (New Living

v)

1 On the day of Pentecost, seven weeks after Jesus' resurrection, the believers were meeting together in one place. **2** Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm in the skies above them, and it filled the house where they were meeting. **3** Then, what looked like **flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them.** **4** And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.

Well it looks like to me, Jesus came through with His promise, to send the Third Part of the Godhead to us, in the Person of the Holy Spirit **Hallelujah!!!!** He is not forgotten of the Lord, but it seems He is forgotten by most of us who teach the word of God to others. Well, you may say, but that was for the Jews, the Holy Spirit came upon the Jews you say. What about us Gentiles, was the Holy Spirit even promised to us? I am glad you asked? Lets take a look into the Word of God again, lets go.

Acts 10:43-48(Good News

Bible)

43 All the prophets spoke about **Him**, saying that **all who believe in Him** will have their sins forgiven through the power of His Name." **44** While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit came down on all those who were listening to his message. **45** The Jewish believers who had come from Joppa with Peter were amazed that **God had poured out His gift of the Holy Spirit on the Gentiles also.** **46** For they heard them speaking in strange tongues and praising God's

greatness. Peter spoke up: **47 "These people have received the Holy Spirit, just as we also did.** Can anyone, then, stop them from being baptized with water?" **48** So he ordered them to be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay with them for a few days. And there you have it, us Gentiles where not forgotten in the promise of God.

We to are the temple of the Holy Spirit, as the Word of God says in I Corinthians 6:17-20

17 But he who joins himself to the **Lord** becomes **spiritually one with Him.** **18** **Avoid immorality. Any other sin a man commits does not affect his body; but the man who is guilty of sexual immorality sins against his own body.** **19** Don't you know that **your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit,** who lives in you and who was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourselves but to God; **20 He bought you for a price. So use your bodies for God's glory.**

So we know that the Holy Spirit did come, and He dwells in us, and we will see He is also with us. So why are we not taught to let the Holy Spirit take control of our lives, and lead us and guide into all truth? That is what He came for, well I believe that is just one of the reasons He came for . Lets take another look, lets recap what was said earlier about what the Holy Spirit was sent to do. **1. Testify of Jesus, and bear witness of the truth. 2. Convict** the world of their **sins** and **righteousness** and of **judgment. 3. The Spirit of Truth will guide you into all truth. 4. He shall not speak of Himself,** but whatever **He** hears, **He** shall speak. **5. And He will announce to you things to come. 6. He** will **glorify Jesus. 7. He** will receive from Jesus and will announce *it* to us.

So the Spirit of Truth is sent to personally live inside me, guide me into all truth, tell me what Jesus is saying to me; announce to me the things which are to come in the future, He will glorify Jesus, and announce what He is receiving from Jesus to all of us individually, and collectively. How many of us are being taught to receive in our lives, these seven areas of Holy Spirit? He was sent to place inside of us, these seven areas from Jesus Christ our Lord Himself? **Hallelujah!!!!** I think it is time, no pass time for us to learn, and to acquire information about how to receive these seven areas of the Holy Spirit, and allow Him to operate in these seven areas in our lives. I am not going to allow the Holy Spirit to remain forgotten in my life. I will not live another day without acquiring information about the seven areas of the Holy Spirit that should be active in my life. If Jesus said it, I believe it. I want more than just a feeling, I want more than just a bunch of noise. I don't know about you, but I want the fullness of the Holy Spirit, and the Godhead operating in my life, right now. I want to know how to manifest all of Him, not some of Him, but all of Him in my life. And I want Him operating in me without any struggle from me, that's hindering me from manifesting all of Him. Well you might say, brother, do you have the Holy Spirit? I would say, I do, without a doubt. But I am asking who do you see walking like Jesus, and doing greater things then He did? Again I say, Jesus said it, and I believe it. That is why I keep saying, I want to manifest all of Him, yes all of Him that is inside of me, and have Him operating through me now. I can't settle for less, you can if you want too, but I can't any longer, I just can't. I don't want to act like I have all of Him manifesting in me when I don't, and I don't want to pretend or make believe that I am walking in a dimension that I am not. Either we are walking like Jesus, or we are not. If we are not, it's time to stop pretending and just be transparent before the Lord and say, teach me how to manifest all of You, so You can use every part of me. Well you may say is it possible to have the Holy Spirit and not manifest all of Him. Lets see what Apostle Paul said he prayed for, for the saints in Ephesians 3:14-19(God's Word

v)

14 This is the reason I kneel in the presence of the Father

15 from whom all the family in heaven and on earth receives its name.

16 **I'm asking God to give you a gift from the wealth of His glory. I pray that He would give you inner strength and power through His Spirit.**

17 **Then Christ will live in you through faith. I also pray that love may be the ground into which you sink your roots and on which you have your foundation.**

18 This way, with all of God's people **you will be able to understand** how wide, long, high, and deep His love is.

19 **You will know Christ's love**, which goes far beyond any knowledge. **I am praying** this so that **you may be completely filled with God.**

20 Glory belongs to God, **whose power is at work in us.** By this power He can do infinitely more than we can ask or imagine.

21 Glory belongs to God in the church and in **Christ Jesus** for all time and eternity! Amen.

Verse 19 is what I am talking about , **You will know Christ's love, which goes far beyond any knowledge. I am praying this so that you may be completely filled with God.**

I want the complete fullness of the manifestation of the Godhead manifesting in me and through me. I want to be apart of the generation that is nameless, and faceless, and can say, if you've seen me you have seen the Father, because He is living in me **Hallelujah!!!!** Let me share another scripture with you. I think we really don't get the full meaning of it, because we don't take in the full scripture. We usually stop short of it , or just overlook it all together. That would be Ephesians 4:10-13 (God's Word V)

10 The One who had gone down also went up above all the heavens so that He fills everything.

11 He also **gave apostles, prophets, missionaries**, as well as **pastors and teachers as gifts to His church.**

12 **Their purpose is to prepare God's people**, to serve, and to build up **the body of Christ.**

13 **This is to continue until all of us are united in our faith and in our knowledge about God's Son, until we become mature, until we measure up to Christ, who is the standard. Woe!!!!**

Most of us like to talk about the **apostles, prophets, missionaries**, as well as **pastors and teachers.** And we love to be prophesied too, and get our word of knowledge going on. But I would like to bring this part of the scripture out to you. All five offices are **gifts to His church, the Body of Christ** to build up God's people **until all of us are united in our faith and in our knowledge about God's Son, until we become mature, until we measure up to Christ, who is the standard.** I don't want to get caught up in this subject right now, I just know that I am not walking in the fullness of the manifestation of the Godhead, but I desire too. Because I know that we can, we are suppose to. The five fold ministry was suppose to usher us to a place, to get us to the **until all of us are united in our faith and in our knowledge about God's Son, until we become mature, until we measure up to Christ, who is the standard.** I want to walk in the maturity of the Holy Spirit. I want to measure up to Christ, who is my standard for life, and for living. Is their anybody out there who understands what I am trying to say? Enough with all the talk, speeches, and sermons, I must move in the power and

demonstration of the Holy Spirit as Paul did. I want to walk in the fullness of the promises of God, I want to enter into my rest. Where I know without a doubt the Holy Spirit is living His life in me, and carrying out the full will of God through me. I am not talking about my own will power and ability in the natural, doing things for God. I'm talking about God's power in me, in the person of the Holy Spirit doing His work in me and through me **Hallelujah!!!!** We know that the Holy Spirit is here, and He is in us and with us, no doubt. But what I long for, and desire, what I hunger, and thirst for, is a walk in the dimension Jesus said we could walk in. John 14:12 (Gods Word v) says

"I can guarantee this truth: Those who believe in Me will do the things that I am doing. They will do even greater things because I am going to the Father. Jesus healed the sick raised the dead, cause the blind to see, the lame began to walk. And Jesus said after the Holy Spirit has come upon you, you shall have power. Power for what? To be a witness For Him, to heal the sick, raise the dead, give sight to the blind, and cause the lame to walk again Hallelujah!!!! Jesus said in I John 4:17 (M King James v)

17 In this is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment, that **as He is, so also we are in this world.**

Well what about Galatians 3:27 (Good News Bible)

27 You were baptized into union with Christ, and now **you are clothed, so to speak, with the life of Christ Himself.**

Well what about II Corinthians 3:16-18 (Good News Bible v)

16 But whenever a person turns to the Lord, **the veil is taken away.**
17 **This Lord is the Spirit. Wherever the Lord's Spirit is, there is freedom.**
18 As all of us reflect the Lord's glory with faces that are not covered with veils, **we are being changed into His image with ever-increasing glory.** This comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

Look, I can go on and on about us being like Christ, **as He is, so are we** in this world. **You are clothed with the life of Christ Himself, we are being changed into His image with ever-increasing glory.** I want to be just like Christ because the word says I can over and over again. And I think the reason why we are not walking and living like Christ is because, we are not finding that rest in the Holy Spirit and letting Him take control in our lives. **Either He is in control or we are.** He can not, and will not, try to lead people who are ,and want to be in control of there own lives one moment, and give Him control the next. **Either He is in control or we are.** I want more than just words, I want power and demonstration manifesting in my every day walk. I refuse to act like everything is ok when it is not. I refuse to search, and study about Christ, and not be able to walk in Him. I do not need power when I die, I need it right now praise the Lord, in this world. I believe the Holy Spirit has been forgotten by us because we have not acquired the information on how to manifest the fullness of the Holy Spirit in our lives. So we chose to believe it was up to us to do what we could not get the Holy Spirit to do in our lives for us. So some of us began the say, God is not working like that anymore; God stop all His works in the book of Acts so we don't see the Holy Spirit moving the way He use too. I have one problem with that, Acts is the only book in the Bible that doesn't end with Amen, because we are living epistles. So Acts never ended, Acts just keeps going and going on while we live. So that can't be a reason why we are not manifesting the gifts of

The Holy Spirit. I cannot forget Him, I will not forget Him. But I will keep desiring to walk in the fullness of the Holy Spirit until I die, I must get to those until'. The until parts are very important, I know they are a key to yours, and my arrival into the fullness. Lets look at them one more time shall we, **until all of us are united in our faith and in our knowledge about God's Son, until we become mature, until we measure up to Christ, who is the standard.** 1. We must be united in our faith, and in our knowledge about God's Son. So now I know I must **believe, and have faith** in, and have the **right knowledge about God's Son Jesus.** I need to know the difference between the Blood, and the Cross. I need the knowledge on the death, burial, and resurrection, of Christ so I can apply them in my life. And I need to know about the exchange that took place on the cross for me, so I can claim what is rightfully mine right now Hallelujah!!!!
2 **Until we become mature.** We must grow up in Christ Jesus, Ephesians 4:14-15(God's Word v)

Says, 14 Then we will no longer be little children, tossed and carried about by all kinds of teachings that change like the wind. We will no longer be influenced by people who use cunning and clever strategies to lead us astray.

15 Instead, as we lovingly speak the truth, **we will grow up completely in our relationship to Christ, who is the head.**

Galatians 4:1-7 (M King James v) says,

- 1 But I say, Over so long a time the **heir is an infant**, he does not differ from a slave, though being lord of all;
- 2 **but he is under guardians and housemasters until the term appointed before by the father.**
- 3 **Even so we, when we were infants, were in bondage under the elements of the world.**
- 4 But when the **fullness of the time came**, God sent forth His Son, coming into being out of a woman, having come under Law,
- 5 **that He might redeem those under Law, so that we might receive the adoption of sons.**
- 6 And because **you are sons**, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

II Corinthians 3:1-3 (New Living Bible) says,

- 1 Dear brothers and sisters, when I was with you I couldn't talk to you **as I would to mature Christians.** I had to talk as though you belonged to this world or as though you were **infants in the Christian life.**
- 2 I had to feed you with milk and not with solid food, because **you couldn't handle anything stronger. And you still aren't ready,**
- 3 **for you are still controlled by your own sinful desires.** You are jealous of one another and quarrel with each other. Doesn't that prove you are controlled by your own desires? You are acting like people who don't belong to the Lord.

Hebrews 5:12-14 (New Living Bible v)

12 You have been Christians a long time now, and **you ought to be teaching others.** Instead, you need someone to teach you again the basic things a beginner must learn about the Scriptures. **You are like babies who drink only milk and cannot eat solid food.**

13 And a person who is living on milk isn't very far along in the Christian life and doesn't know much about doing what is right.

14 **Solid food is for those who are mature**, who have trained themselves to recognize the difference between right and wrong and **then do what is right.**

—
Hebrews 6:1-3 (New Living Bible v)

1 So let us stop going over the basics of Christianity again and again. **Let us go on instead and become mature in our understanding.** Surely we don't need to start all over again with the importance of turning away from evil deeds and placing our faith in God.

2 You don't need further instruction about baptisms, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.

3 And so, **God willing, we will move forward to further understanding.**

I John 2:12-16 (New Living Bible v)

12 I am writing to you, my dear children, **because your sins have been forgiven because of Jesus.**

13 **I am writing to you who are mature** because you know Christ, the one who is from the beginning. I am writing to you who are young because **you have won your battle with Satan.**

14 I have written to you, children, because **you have known the Father. I have written to you who are mature** because you know Christ, the one who is from the beginning. I have written to you who are young because **you are strong with God's word living in your hearts,** and you have won your battle with Satan.

15 **Stop loving this evil world and all that it offers you,** for when you love the world, **you show that you do not have the love of the Father in you.**

16 For the world offers only the lust for physical pleasure, the lust for everything we see, and pride in our possessions. **These are not from the Father.** They are from this evil world.

So we must mature in Christ, and in our way of living, in our speech, and actions. We must love God and hate evil, we must love the Kingdom of God, and hate the world's way of doing things.

Until number 3 says, **until we measure up to Christ, who is the standard.** In order for me to measure up to Christ, who is the standard, we must understand we are in Christ, and we are one with Christ. We are not trying to be like Christ, we are letting Christ live in us Hallelujah!!!! This is where I want to live in the paradox of the word of God. John 17:11, 15-26 (Good news Bible v)

11 And now I am coming to you; I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world. Holy Father! Keep them safe by the Power of Your Name, the Name You gave Me, **so that they may be one just as You and I are one.**

15 I do not ask You to take them out of the world, but I do ask You to keep them safe from the Evil One.

16 **Just as I do not belong to the world, they do not belong to the world.**

17 Dedicate them to Yourself by means of the truth; **Your Word is Truth.**

18 **I sent them into the world, just as You sent Me into the world.**

19 And for their sake I dedicate Myself to You, in order that they, too, may be truly dedicated to You.

20 "I pray not only for them, **but also for those who believe in Me because of their message.**

21 **I pray that they may all be one.** Father! **May they be in Us, just as You are in Me and I am in You.** May **they be one**, so that the world will believe that You sent Me.

22 **I gave them the same glory you gave Me**, so that **they may be one, just as You and I are one:**

23 **I in them and You in Me**, so that **they may be completely one**, in order that the world may know that **You sent Me and that You love them as You love Me.**

24 "Father! You have given them to Me, and I want them to be with Me where I am, so that they may see My glory, the glory You gave Me; for You loved Me before the world was made.

25 Righteous Father! The world does not know You, but I know You, and these know that You sent Me.

26 I made You known to them, and I will continue to do so, in order that **the love You have for Me may be in them**, and so that **I also may be in them.**"

I must learn how to live in the paradox of this word Jesus in me, me in Jesus, and Jesus in God. Is this understandable? Not with the human mind, not with any knowledge that man can come up with. That is why I said this is a paradox to us, how can I be in Him and Him in me at the same time? Lets look at John 15: 1-9

1 **I am the True Vine, and My Father is the Vinedresser.**

2 Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away. And every one that bears fruit, He prunes it so that it may bring forth more fruit.

3 Now you are clean through the Word which I have spoken to you.

4 **Abide in Me, and I in you.** As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it remains in the vine, so neither *can* you unless **you abide in Me.**

5 I am the Vine, you *are* the branches. **He who abides in Me, and I in him,** the same **brings forth much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.**

6 If anyone does not **abide in Me**, he is cast out as a branch and is withered. And they gather and cast *them* into the fire, and they are burned.

7 **If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you,** you shall ask what you will, and it shall be done to you.

8 In this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit, so you shall be My disciples.

9 **As the Father has loved Me, so I have loved you; continue in My love.**

Well, in the spirit realm, this is not a paradox, because we understand we are in Jesus while the Holy Spirit is in us Hallelujah!!!! I do not just want to know or read about the Spiritual realms, and dimensions I want to live, and walk in them all the days of my life. The Holy Spirit will not be a forgotten part of my life. I want to operate in all seven areas of the Holy Spirit that He was sent to carry out in me. Let it be so according to Your Word Lord Jesus.
